

Garda Dolomiti Superfishing Permit

REGULATIONS 2026

IMPORTANT

Before starting to fish in each individual fishing area, anglers must declare the selected fishing zone in the digital permit.

Introduction

This permit allows fishing in numerous waters, including lakes, rivers, streams and channels, both alpine and valley waters, within the Garda Dolomiti area, part of the UNESCO Dolomites World Heritage Site.

Several waters are open all year round.

The permit is intended exclusively for **NO-KILL fishing**. Anglers may use various authorized techniques and artificial lures to target several fish species, including Arctic char, marble trout, rainbow trout, brown trout, lake trout, grayling, whitefish, pike, chub and perch.

The fishing waters are distributed across south-western Trentino and form the largest provincial fishing consortium, involving the following associations:

1. **Amateur Sport Fishing Association of Molveno** – 2 lakes
 2. **Alto Chiese Anglers Association** – 37 waters
 3. **Alto Sarca Amateur Anglers Association** – 20 waters
 4. **Ledro Valley Amateur Anglers Association** – 1 lake
 5. **Lower Sarca Amateur Sport Anglers Association** – 17 waters
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Art. 1 – Movement Between Fishing Areas

Within the same day, the permit holder may fish in **one or more fishing areas** listed in Art. 7.

IMPORTANT

Before starting to fish in **each individual area**, the angler must **declare the fishing zone in the digital permit**.

Art. 2 – Fishing Activity and Angler Conduct

- Fishing is allowed only to holders of a valid fishing permit purchased through the **Trentino Fishing** portal.
- The permit is **personal, non-transferable**, and valid only on the dates indicated.
- Anglers must comply with any **temporary fishing bans** issued by the Province of Trento or by the managing associations.
- Anglers must behave correctly toward other anglers and show respect to control officers.
- Maximum respect for **private property** is required.

Wading restrictions

- In waters managed by the **Alto Sarca Association**, fishing must be carried out **from the bank (no wading)** until **30 March**.
- In waters managed by the **Alto Chiese Association**, the same restriction applies until **30 April**.
- Crossing the water is allowed **only when not fishing**.

Controls and inspections

- Upon request, anglers must present all documents proving their right to fish.
- Anglers fishing from boats must return to shore when requested by control officers.
- Upon request, anglers must immediately retrieve the line and show lures and equipment used.
- For inspection purposes, anglers must open portable containers or transport equipment, excluding private dwellings.

Safety and environmental protection

- Anglers must not interfere with the fishing activity of others.
- **Littering is strictly prohibited**, both on land and in water.
- Special attention must be paid to signs warning of **sudden water level increases**.
- Extreme caution is required when using **carbon or similar rods** near power lines or during storms.
- Any dangerous situation, pollution or environmental damage must be reported immediately to control authorities.

Emergency: in case of emergency, the emergency number for the Province of Trento is **112**.

Art. 3 – Start and End of the Fishing Day

Fishing may start **one hour before sunrise** and must end **one hour after sunset**.

Art. 4 – Gear and Bait

- Access to fishing areas is allowed **only with fishing gear, landing net and related accessories**.
Containers or baskets intended to transport fish previously caught in other waters are **not allowed**.
- Only **one fishing rod** may be used at any time.

Authorized fishing techniques

Fly fishing

Fly fishing is permitted using:

- fly line,
- fixed line,
- Valsesiana,
- Tenkara,
- strike indicator (float),

with **dry fly, terrestrial fly, nymph or streamer**, subject to:

- single lure only,
- maximum two hooks,
- barbless hooks only.

Spinning

Spinning is permitted using **artificial lures only**, including:

- spinners,
- spoons,
- hard baits (minnow / rapala),
- silicone lures mounted on a **single hook**,
- spin-fly.

⚠ Silicone lures are not permitted in waters managed by the **Alto Chiese** and **Alto Sarca** associations.

Pike fishing

- When fishing for pike, the use of a **steel or fluorocarbon leader** with a **minimum diameter of 0.8 mm** is mandatory.
- The use of **fish grips (boga grip)** to land fish is **strictly prohibited**.

General prohibitions

- **All hooks must be barbless.**
- The use of **natural bait** or **groundbait of any kind** is **strictly prohibited**.

Art. 5 – Catch and Release

- **Keeping fish is strictly prohibited.**

- All fish must be **unhooked with the utmost care** and **must never be removed from the water**.
- The use of a **landing net is mandatory**.

Art. 6 – Fishing in Flowing Waters During October

Fishing in flowing waters during the month of **October** is permitted **every day of the week**, subject to the rules below.

Fly-Only Areas

- Only **one rod** may be used.
- A maximum of **two barbless flies** (dry fly or nymph) is allowed.
- **All other fishing techniques are prohibited.**
- Authorized fly-fishing methods: fly line, fixed line, Tenkara and Valsesiana.

Fly / Spinning Areas

- Only **one rod** may be used.
- A maximum of **two barbless hooks** is allowed.
- **Natural bait, soft baits (rubber/silicone) and dough baits are prohibited.**

Authorized artificial lures:

- Dry fly, nymph, streamer (maximum length **6 cm**)
(fly line or fixed line, Tenkara, Valsesiana, fly rig with final float)
- Metal lures
- Minnows and other hard lures (maximum length **6 cm**)

Art. 7 – Fishing Areas, Seasons and Specific Rules

Below is the list of all fishing areas included in this permit.

The **first number of each zone** identifies the managing association, as listed in the introduction (e.g. **5.A** refers to waters managed by the **Lower Sarca Amateur Sport Anglers Association**).

All fishing areas are subject to the **NO-KILL obligation**, unless otherwise specified.

Art. 8 – Penalties

Any violation of these regulations is subject to the **sanctions provided by current Provincial law.**
